Medication

School staff can administer medication in the following circumstances:



- . A medicine form has been completed at the school office
- . The child's name, address and date of issue should be clearly marked on the prescription
- . Prescribed medicine should be in date
- . **Only medicine prescribed to be taken 4 times a day or more will be administered**

All medicines should be brought in/picked up from the school office by a parent/guardian each day. We are unable to give Calpol **unless** it has been prescribed by your GP.

Children enjoyed a day out at Zorbas, where we had the chance to experience some Greek foods, have a go at some Greek dancing and we learnt how to write our names in Greek.



This half term in English, we have been learning about various Greek Myths and using them to inspire our writing.
