We have our **Holy Souls boxes** at both churches. White slips and plain envelopes are for names of loved ones; envelopes with writing on (brown at St Anne's, white at Corpus Christi) are for Mass offerings, towards Masses for the Holy Souls.

CORPUS CHRISTI COMMUNITY CENTRE The diocese came to look at what we are doing and planning - and were very impressed. Unless there's any complaints in the next two weeks, it looks like we'll be granted faculty by then, as it is called.

Thank you so much for joining in our public consultation - we got nearly 500 forms returned! And some very favourable comments too - from parishioners, footballers, locals and all. We still will have our two meetings - parish Council 22nd, and parish 29th, 7.15pm both, but with so much positive and no negative feedback, it seems the path ahead is clear. Nevertheless, the final sheet I promised you is available this weekend - with a chance to fill in a feedback form and pop it in the box, for the parish council to consider.

An unusual request - but every grant is different! We can apply for a grant from the FCC who look after landfill sites. This process actually costs them money, and so for a grant to be considered, we have to have what they called Third Party Contributors to say they are willing to give money to them, to offset their costs. In our case, we are asking for £50,000, but in order to get that we need to offer them £5,375. Is anyone willing to give, we pretty well get £10. If you are willing to offer any amount, could you give me a letter saying that you are willing to be a Contributing Third Party to FCC in relation to the grant application for help with renovating and reopening Corpus Christi Community Centre, Coventry. Letters need to be given me in the next two weeks.


