The only catch is connected to the group getting our grant application for internal refurbishment ready. We've had to have the trees in front of the centre cut down - they have damaged the drainage system, even to the point of causing the church cellar to flood more - and would damage the building. It's always sad to chop trees down, but it was essential, and wow has it changed the look of the centre - it's like it has suddenly reappeared. It has really changed the upstairs view from the presbytery - it's like I've gained 6 more neighbours!
