CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION 3PM this Sunday. Forecast says 0% chance of rain - yes, 0% chance, so make that effort come 2.30pm (or earlier, if you're the one preparing the picnic! Don't forget the blanket to sit on). My suggestion is to drop passengers off at St Anne's, park in Corpus Christi, then walk up for 3pm start. If you can't do the walk, just come to Corpus Christi for 3.45pm and join in Benediction. The First Holy Communion children will lead the procession, in their posh clothes from the day before, and it is a great chance for us to join in their celebration.
