### **RE project - Research our class saint- Saint John Bosco and write a fact file on him.**

### **Writing project – Create a newspaper article that will become part of a class newspaper. Your article should be a journalistic recount of an event that has happened to you. You may want to add pictures or adverts.**

In your writing, I expect to see the use of conjunctions and paragraphs. Remember to write in the past tense and in first person. Your article should have a catchy headline and it should be written in two columns. Remember to include the W's!

### **Creative Curriculum – The Victorians were famous for their inventions and toys. Your project is to design your own toy. Write an explanation text for how to use it.**

For this project, I expect to see that you are using a range of art and design skills such as drawing and construction. Your writing should be organised into chronological steps with a question as a title.
