

**ARCHDIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM  
PARISH BOUNDARIES  
CORPUS CHRISTI, ERNESFORD GRANGE, COVENTRY**

Interpretation of Boundaries:

1. A house or institution belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road into which opens its principal entrance.
2. A cul-de-sac, crescent, etc., having official opening(s) only onto one road belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road having such official opening(s), unless the contrary be expressly stated.
3. The boundary always follows the middle of roads, lanes, footpaths, rivers, etc., unless stated otherwise.

Starting in the north at the junction of Binley Road and Hipswell Highway:

1. West along BINLEY ROAD to Brindle Avenue (neither side);
2. South along BRINDLE AVENUE to Bourne Road (neither side);
3. West along BOURNE ROAD and GLENCOE ROAD to Bulls Head Lane (neither side);
4. South-west along BULLS HEAD LANE to Siddeley Avenue (neither side);  
South along SIDDELEY AVENUE to Whitworth Avenue (neither side);
6. West along the continuation of SIDDELEY AVENUE to Aldermoor Lane;
7. South along ALDERMOOR LANE to Pinley Gardens;
8. South-west through PINLEY GARDENS to Humber Road (both sides);
9. South along HUMBER ROAD to the Railway Line (neither side);
10. South-east along the RAILWAY LINE to Willenhall Lane;
11. North-east along WILLENHALL LANE towards Brandon to the Drive to Brandon Hall;
12. North-east along the DRIVE TO BRANDON HALL and continuing through the grounds along the ROAD LEADING TO THE BRANDON (RUGBY) ROAD (neither side);
13. North-west along the BRANDON (RUGBY) ROAD to the Binley and Brinklow Road (both sides);
14. West along BINLEY ROAD to Hipswell Highway.
