



Corpus Christi's Sanction Steps

8

A Permanent Exclusion will be issued.

7

A formal meeting with the principal, parents and the Local Academy will be held.

6

If this continues or aggressive or verbally abusive behaviour is displayed, the child will receive a Fixed Term Exclusion.

5

If the child has been on Red three times within a half term, parents will be invited into school for a formal meeting with the principal or a member of SLT.

4

Steps 1-3 will be repeated before the child's name is turned to Red. The child will miss some break times or may be removed from class into internal exclusion at the discretion of SLT. Parents will be informed.

3

If unwanted behaviour persists, the child's name will be changed to yellow on the Good to be Green chart and recorded. The child can still turn yellow back to Green throughout the day by showing the expected behaviour.

2

The child will be given a second verbal warning reminding them of the unacceptable behaviour being displayed and a reminder of the school rule that they are not adhering to.

1

The child will be given a verbal or non-verbal warning as a reminder for behaviour that is unacceptable, disruptive to learning which will link to one of our school rules.
